Summary Description of the IPAC Lapse

An inspection of KN Nail Design was conducted in response to a complaint, from a member of the public, who believed they developed an infection after receiving a manicure at the establishment.

Upon arrival, the following infection control concerns were noticed:

1. Failed to dispose of single-use items after use (such as buffers and nail files)
2. Failed to store single-use items in a clean and sanitary condition.
3. Failed to keep a log every time a fresh disinfectant is made .
4. Fail to store disinfectant in a appropriately labeled container.
5. Failed to properly clean and disinfect foot baths.

5. Foot baths are now being cleaned properly.
