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Temporary Immunization Exemption Process for ISPA Non-Medical Exemptions: Parent Information

Under the [Immunization of School Pupils Act \(ISPA\)](#), your child can be exempted from important immunizations for medical reasons or due to conscience or religious belief. Please follow the below steps to complete the conscience or religious belief exemption process:

1. Complete the Immunization Education Session that covers:
 - Basic information about immunization
 - Vaccine safety
 - Immunization and community health
 - Immunization law in Ontario

2. Notify a Public Health Nurse that you have completed the Immunization Education Session by e-mailing vpdnurse@county-lambton.on.ca or calling 519-383-8331 x 3822. Provide your full name, your child's full name and date of birth and your phone number.
3. A Public Health Nurse will email you a signed and dated Vaccine Education Certificate.
4. **Complete** a [Statement of Conscience or Religious Belief form](#) and get it signed by a [commissioner for taking affidavits in Ontario](#).
5. **Make copies** of your Vaccine Education Certificate and your signed Statement of Conscience or Religious Belief form and submit the originals to Lambton Public Health by mail or in person at:
