Local survey results to inform the COVID-19 vaccine rollout for children aged 5 to 11

## 6 in 10 parents

said that they were likely to vaccinate their child aged 5 to 11 against COVID-19 when they became eligible



## 44% of parents

who planned to vaccinate their 8 to 11 year old child preferred to do so at a family-friendly community clinic. 38% of parents preferred this option for their 5 to 7 year old child.

## 29% of parents

who planned to vaccinate their 8 to 11 year old child preferred to do so at their child's school, either during or after school hours. 26% of parents preferred this option for their 5 to 7 year old child.



## 15% of parents

who planned to vaccinate their 8 to 11 year old child preferred to do so at the clinic of their child's doctor/primary care provider. 25% of parents preferred this option for their 5 to 7 year old child.

## 92% of parents

who did not plan to vaccinate their 5 to 17 year old child were worried about potential side-effects of the vaccine on their child.
