

Grade 7-12 Publicly Funded Vaccines

HPV-9

Age: 14 & Under

- 2 doses
- Interval: 0 & 6 months

Age: 15 & Older

- 3 doses
- Interval: 0, 2 & 6 months
- If series started before 15, continue 2 dose schedule

Eligibility Extension

- Females born 2002 2006
- · Males born 2004
- To be completed by Aug 31, 2024

Hep-B(HB)

Age: 11-15

- 2 doses (1.0mL)
- Interval: 0,& 6 months
- If series not complete prior to turning 16 years of age, 3 dose series required.

Age: 16-19

- 3 doses (0.5mL)
- Interval: 0,1&6 months

Eligibility Extension

- Students born 2005 2006
- To be completed by Aug 31, 2024

Varicella / Chickenpox

No previous doses

- 2 doses
- Interval: 0 & 3 months

One previous dose

Administer 2nd dose only

Eligibility

• Born in or after 2000

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Men-C-ACYW

• 1 dose

Also eligible

 Students born in or after 1997

Tdap

Age: 14 to 16

 Administered 10 years following the 4 -6 year old Tdap-IPV

Interuption of a vaccine series does not require restarting the series.
