Human Rabies in Ontario

Ontario's Chief Medical Officer of Health has alerted Public Health Units, Ontario Hospital CEOs, and Primary Care Providers that earlier this week they received notice of a case of clinical rabies in Ontario. The case was exposed to a bat in Ontario. This marks the first domestically acquired case of human rabies in Ontario since 1967. Further details are within the attached memo from Ontario's Chief Medical Officer of Health sent today.
