

A school guide for parents and caregivers

ABOUT THE ACT

The Smoke-Free Ontario Act (SFOA) prohibits smoking and vaping in schools or on school property, including:

- All public areas within 20 metres of school property
- School parking lots, including inside vehicles
- All areas of the school, including washrooms
- Sports fields
- Buses

ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement Officers from Lambton Public Health carry out inspections and respond to complaints related to the Smoke-Free Ontario Act. When a student commits a tobacco/vapour offence, an Enforcement Officer is contacted and may issue a warning, a charge, or a summons to court.

PENALTIES

Smoke or vape on or within 20 metres of school property, 16 years of age or older.

First Offence:

Multiple Offences: \$5000 (maximum fine)

\$305 (minimum fine) \$1000 (maximum fine)

Smoke or vape on or within 20 metres of school property, less than 16 years of age.

First Offence: Must attend court

Multiple Offences: \$5000 (maximum fine)

Sale or supply of tobacco or vapour products to someone less than 19 years of age.

First Offence:

Multiple Offences:

\$490 (minimum fine) \$800 (maximum fine) \$200,000 (maximum fine)



DEFINITIONS

CHARGE

Commonly referred to as a ticket or offence notice.

SUMMONS TO COURT

Notice instructing a person they must appear in court on a particular date and time.

SMOKING

Smoking or holding of lighted tobacco or cannabis (including medical).

VAPING

Inhaling or exhaling vapour from an electronic cigarette or holding an activated electronic cigarette, whether or not the vapour contains nicotine or cannabis.

WARNING

Documented verbal or written message from Enforcement Officers regarding an offence without a charge.
