COVID-19 updates related to COVaxON, clinical viewer, and vaccine certificates

To healthcare providers,

Please see the following COVID-19 updates related to COVaxON, clinical viewer, and vaccine certificates on behalf of the Vaccine Policy and Programs Branch of the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health.

COVaxON: Addition of the new LP.8.1 formulation of COVID-19 vaccine on September 22, 2025

- Healthcare providers will be able to record their inventory and administered doses of the new COVID-19 formulation in COVaxON starting September 22.
- This date aligns to the start date of COVID-19 vaccine distribution.

Clinical viewer: Inclusion of the administration data of the new formulation of COVID-19 vaccine on October 7, 2025

- Administration data for the new vaccine formulation will be included in the clinical viewer starting October 7.
- Healthcare providers should use COVaxON between September 22 and October 6 to view the most update to date COVID-19 immunization history for their clients.

Vaccine certificate: Addition of the new formulation of COVID-19 vaccine on October 7, 2025

- The new formulation of COVID-19 vaccine will be reflected on the vaccine certificate starting October 7.
- Healthcare providers, when administering doses between September 22 and October 6, should advise their clients that they will be able to obtain their updated COVID-19 vaccine certificate starting October 7.

Please note that the old formulation of COVID-19 (KP.2) has been withdrawn and should not be administered. If the KP.2 formulation is selected a warning will display in COVaxON. Healthcare providers can still make corrections to historical information pertaining to doses of KP.2 if required.
