

# A message from Lambton Public Health

## RSV Updates for 2025-26

Sept. 10, 2025

Lambton Public Health is sharing the Ontario Ministry of Health updated immunization eligibility criteria for the 2025/26 RSV prevention program. Please see the attached information package to assist with implementation for older adults, infants, and high-risk children.

## **Key Updates for the 2025/26 Season:**

- Older Adults: Now includes all adults 75 years of age and older.
- Infants and High-Risk Children: Eligibility remains consistent with previous guidance.
- Fulsome eligibility and administration guidance are within the Ministry of Health documents attached and at the Ministry of Health website.

### **Program Launch Timelines:**

- The older adult RSV prevention program is <u>available for order on the LPH website</u>, with product shipment from the Ministry of Health anticipated soon.
- The infant RSV prevention program will launch on October 1, 2025, and doses of Beyfortus can be ordered now on the LPH website for administration to eligible recipients on or after the launch date. At this time, 100 mg doses are available through LPH. 50 mg doses will become available once the shipment is received from the Ministry of Health. Hospitals provide access points to administer Beyfortus to newborns before discharge, and Primary Care Providers and Specialists can also order and administer Beyfortus for eligible infants in the community. In addition, Abrysvo may be considered for discussion with pregnant patients (GA 32 to 36 weeks) who would prefer to receive the vaccine during pregnancy rather than having their infant receive Beyfortus after birth.
